MATERIALS AND SUPPLY LIST

The art supplies listed below can be purchased at Wet Paint, 1684 Grand Avenue, St. Paul. Some household items will help round out your child's needs.

If you are unable to purchase all the art supplies listed below by the first class, don't worry. Pencils, erasers, and paper are all the materials needed for the first drawing lesson.

Basic Drawing and Painting Supplies *(can be purchased at Wet Paint)*

- 1 - 2H pencil
- 1 - H pencil
- Kneaded eraser
- Pink Pearl eraser
- Higgins Black India Ink
- Crow quill pen nib Hunt #107 and small pen holder
- Crow quill pen nib #512 and large pen holder
- Prang Oval 8 watercolor set
- Richeson watercolor brush #5 or equivalent
- #4 flat watercolor brush (mid-sized to cover larger areas)
- Pencil sharpener
- Inexpensive pad of tracing paper—approximately 9" X 12"
- Colored pencils

Household Items

- Shoebox or Tacklebox to hold art supplies
- Laminated folder to hold drawing and watercolor papers
- 2 small cups or jars
- Lint-free cotton rag
- Sketch Pad of Typing Paper with Construction Paper Covers (stapled together, 10-15 sheets)
- Roll of Paper Towels (to be left at the classroom)

Drawing and Watercolor Papers *(Free from instructor)*

- Strathmore Vellum 2-ply Bristol paper (for inking)
- Arches or Lanaquarelle 140 lb cold press watercolor paper (for watercolor)
