MATERIALS AND SUPPLY LIST

The art supplies listed below can be purchased at an art store like Wet Paint located on 1684 Grand Avenue, St. Paul, and an office supply or drug store. The household items will help round out your child's needs.

If you are unable to purchase all the art supplies listed below by the first class, don't worry. The black and colored markers, sketch pads, bristol pad, pencil and eraser are the only materials needed for the first lesson.

Basic Drawing and Painting Supplies

3 - Black Sharpie permanent markers:

- 1 - Fine Point
- 1 - Super Sharpie

1 - HB pencil

Pink or hard eraser

2 - paint brushes

- #4 flat (mid-sized to cover larger areas)
- #5 Richeson watercolor brush or equivalent

Pad of 11" X 14" Strathmore Watercolor paper, 12 ct., 300 series (has yellow cover)

9" X 12" sketchbook
